# OFF THE BENCH!

For men who hold leadership positions at your church, as well as those who might one day step into leadership positions, RPM offers *Ignite Pathway* training. Over 150 men representing 45 churches have used this half-day training camp to become more effective pastors and ministry leaders.

Grace Bible Church in Florissant, Missouri, hosted Ignite Pathway in April. Here is what their men's ministry leader, Mark (BK) Eason, had to say about the training: "Ten of our men were present. Members of other churches brought the total up to about 45 people. It was a great time.

"We are doing a lot right at our church, but we're always looking for more tools to wake up the bench warmers—the men that come to church, but don't step out of their comfort zone and

never get involved.



"Pastors weren't meant to do everything on their own. Men are needed to come alongside the pastor and help lead. That requires training.

"One of my favorite parts of the Ignite Pathway training was when we broke up into groups by church. There was a sense of urgency, a sense that we'd gotten something, and now had a structure that would make this ministry



## DON'T PUT YOUR MINISTRY IN A BOX

In this age, myriad resources are available to aid in men's ministry and ministry in general. These can be useful, given that you choose wisely. I do want to caution you, though, against the idea that ministry can be found in a box—as if by purchasing a DVD set and workbooks you can check men's ministry off as done. It doesn't work that way. A robust strategy to engage the men of your church and equip them as disciples who will disciple others may incorporate such materials, but the real work is done through investments in time.

One lesson that I've learned over the years of working with ministry teams, is that the most effective way to reach and impact men for the glory of God is the individualized coaching that takes into account the needs of the individual as well as the individual church.

In other words, it's okay to use a box within your ministry, but you never want to put your ministry in a box.
