"I came home from Vietnam with a broken heart following two battles in which I lost most of my best friends. One died in my place, bled out in my arms. I came home to a broken country broken myself...."

So begins the testimony of Phil Downer, President of Discipleship Network of America: a war veteran, former attorney, author of numerous books, and a popular speaker within and outside the United States.

Having heard Phil's redemption story rattled off with military precision (many of his speaking engagements are to the various branches of the military) we decided to share only that bit of it. We don't want to take away any of the thunder he will deliver as a keynote speaker at ISI Champaign on April 6. The only spoiler alert we will offer is that the victory, and Phil, belong to Christ.

Downer uses his story to open minds as he delves into a message on discipleship and its ability to change the world that will inspire men of all generations.

Having worked with his wife to rescue a marriage that was on the brink of divorce, Phil will also host a workshop entitled *Love, Sex, And Marriage God's Way.* "I have a fabulous, vibrant, team-working, intimate marriage now, but there are things we do every day, every week, every month, to keep it that way," he says.
