SUPPORT FOR PASTORS

RPM works to equip, enable, and encourage men to take an active role in the church. A man who is overwhelmed, overextended, or neglecting personal needs is not equipped, enabled, or encouraged.

Among those most susceptible to burn-out in the church are our pastors, who often feel compelled out of concern to take on more and more responsibility.

RPM is aware of this, and as an aside to our usual work, we strive to support pastors not only in men's ministry, but in their personal and spiritual well-being. The most concrete example of this is our pastoral retreat giveaway.

Ten percent of offerings received by RPM at each of our four ISI events anually goes toward funding pastoral retreats. A drawing is held at each ISI conference and our *Leading Noble Men* conference in November, and pastors are selected for an expenses-paid weekend for two at the Chiara Center, a tranquil

and beautiful Christian retreat in Springfield, Illinois (winners are allowed to select a different venue for their weekend if they desire).

This year, we had the funds to present six pastors and their wives with retreats. The point is to give these couples a quiet getaway to restore and reconnect. The giveaway is a small part of RPM's ministry, but it helps fulfill our mandate to be an asset to pastors.


"My faith has deepened over time as I've learned to trust God, and I try to use that as a board member. I'm there to give perspective on finances, operations, that sort of thing.
