Men Leading In The Home

In the words of General Patton "You Fight Like You Train"

We should be ready to fight tonight...in saying that we should not be scrambling or questioning how to lead our families when tough times hit. The training should already be happening, so we simply rely on what we know. In my time in the Army we did a lot of repetitive training and as a young man I saw little value. In fact, it frustrated me that we did things over and over. They would blind fold us and time us on taking our weapon apart. Nearly twenty

years later I get it! I still remember what I was taught and how to do it. They wanted to get key principles into us. Like the military who takes citizens and turns them into soldiers, God desires us as men to lead our families in knowing and living by his commands and word. Last month I shared with you Deuteronomy 6:4-9 which says God should be the most important thing in our life and we have a responsibility to teach our children in the ways of God.

During this national crisis with COVID-19 we should be able to fall back on our training. Men, we need to be leading our families daily in the instruction and teaching of God and his word. There are a ton of great resources that, in conjunction with the physical word of God, will aid you in ensuring that your family sees you modeling that God is the most important thing in your life and that you are relying on him during this difficult and uncertain time. You must lead your family daily in spiritual growth. The problem with only leading 1-2 times a week is that life happens and if you miss then it ends up being a week or longer before guiding them again. So, if your bullseye is daily and life happens, and you miss a day you get back on course the next day. Stay strong in the Lord and lead your family as Proverbs 3:5 puts it to trust in the Lord with all their heart and to not depend on their own understanding.
