George recently shared his testimony with Tom C. Knowing that there are so many men that needed to hear it, Tom asked if he would share his testimony to the RPM community to encourage them to take a step out, and tap into the power of God to break an addiction.

George's testimony....

"For years I struggled with a horrible moral sin that many men have or continue to struggle with, pornography. I thought I could stop

this on my own, but every time I thought I could, I would lapse back into it again. I would feel horrible knowing I was sinning not only against God's will, but against my wife and son too.

Fortunately, some men in my church prompted me to attend and Iron Sharpens Iron conference. I agreed to go, hoping and praying that this would be an answer to help me overcome this addiction. I remember attending a breakout session regarding overcoming pornography. I learned my triggers and that the Lord always provides a way out.

Following the session, I returned to the sanctuary where the ISI band was playing. I could sense the Holy Spirit coming over me and I began to cry and asked the Lord for forgiveness. I then committed to Him that I would surrender myself to His will and not mine.

Upon returning home, I gathered with my wife and son in the kitchen. Sobbing, I told them both of my addiction to pornography, that I had surrendered myself to the Lord, asked for His forgiveness and asked for their forgiveness also.

It has now been 8 years. I continue to pray multiple times a day, I make time to stay in the Word, and I watch out for my triggers. I also attend an ISI conference every year."

George serves at the Springfield ISI each year and attends another city's conference to refuel himself. RPM is eternally grateful for his service to the men of ISI, to his family, and most importantly his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.


