RPM has a strategy to be a resource to the men in the context of their local churches. The 4-week training via Zoom was how we adapted coming out of the first two conferences in 2021. We wanted to offer critical training that men could use to reach and equip their men in this new Covid environment we find ourselves in.

We long to get back to "live" in person training and coaching on a more regular basis; however, the majority of churches are still not there yet. We decided that we would host these weekly one-hour trainings to whet the appetite of the men who came to one of the first two Iron Sharpens Iron (ISI) conferences. Each session builds on the previous and gives the men a strong take-a-way. These sessions give a glimpse of what we provide in the half-day trainings.

We would normally offer the half day trainings post ISI, but sensing this was still a little early in the post covid recovery, we opted to use technology to accomplish something similar. We already knew Zoom was an effective platform, so using it was a simple decision.

We are just about to wrap up the fourth week as we write this. We have



found the training to be much more personalized with the participants in some ways, and that is even more effective than the live trainings! No, we aren't scrapping doing live trainings, but we will take some of the personal elements we have learned and make the live trainings even more effective.

We are thankful for the men who have joined us faithfully each week and look forward to continuing to serve them in 2021 and beyond.

Honoring the Mothers in Your Life

Every one of us came from the birth of a woman, correct?

God is the creator of man and woman; marriage and the family were His idea (Gn 1:26–28). God gave Moses as the fifth commandment to "Honor your father and your mother... (Ex 20:12)." In Leviticus 19:1–3 God is speaking to Moses, He says for him "to tell all the people of Israel that they are to be holy, for I the Lord God am holy.
